Self sufficiancy vulnerable groups



# OVERALL FUNDING ALLOCATED DURING 2024: AWG. 6,145,954




## **OVERALL FUNDING GROWTH:** 2021 - 2024

### PILLAR 1: EMPOWERED CITIZENS

- 40 projects funded supporting active citizenship
- Aruba Doet: 172 projects, 3,500 volunteers mobilized – Aruba's largest volunteer movement
- **ArubaVolunteers:** 95 active NGOs, 600 volunteer matches
- Outreach & Awareness: 50,000+ visitors on ArubaVolunteers.org
- 25 Microprojects & 10 Ban Biba Bario projects supporting grassroots efforts
- International Engagement: 9 youth volunteers sent abroad, 7 international youth volunteers hosted



## PILLAR 2: COMMUNITY WELLBEING & SOLIDARITY

- 89 projects funded addressing community needs
- WAW Mobiel: Engaged **1,666 residents** across 11 neighborhoods
- Ban Caya Initiative: **3 events, 4,750** visitors strengthening community relationships
- NGO Partnerships: **6 new activities** launched, 100 Centro di Bario initiatives supported.
- 1 neighborhood analysis completed to develop local strategies



### PILLAR 3: SELF SUFFICIANCY OF VULNERABLBE GROUPS

For many migrants and refugees in Aruba, language barriers limit access to job opportunities and social inclusion. Through CEDE ARUBA's collaboration with HIAS and Cas di Papiamento, a free language program provides essential Papiamento and English courses, empowering vulnerable individuals to integrate into society.

"This program gave me the confidence to communicate, find work, and feel like I belong."

One participant shared her gratitude. Now employed, she hopes to support others facing similar challenges, proving that language is a key step toward stability and inclusion.

## PILLAR 4: STRONG & COLLABORATIVE ORGANIZATIONS

Through its **Bario Unico** program, CEDE ARUBA has played a key role in reviving and strengthening community centers across the island. Many district centers faced challenges in sustainability, but with CEDE's training sessions, Centro di Bario boards and staff gained essential skills in business planning, resource management, and financial stability.

"Having a clear plan allows us to serve our communities better and create lasting impact."

One participant reflected on this, noting that with stronger leadership, these centers are now better equipped to support and empower their communities.

## CHALLENGES & LESSONS LEARNED

• Reaching Vulnerable Populations – Many people in need avoid seeking help due to stigma or legal concerns. Strengthening trusted local community organizations and networks is key.

• **Sustainability Concerns** – Many programs rely on short-term funding. Long-term funding, public-private partnerships and social entrepreneurship are critical for sustainability.

### **Strategic Goals 2025**

- Developing Youth Work Structure with BARIO UNICO and NGO partners
- Designing a National Community Prevention Center together with NGO partners
- Expanding NGO participation in Centro di Bario's and community spaces
- Creating a recreational area in Lago Heights Park
- Exploring long-term funding models for vulnerable groups
- Capacity Building Strategy for Aruba, Curação & Sint Maarten NGOs
